SUBJECT: Aligning COVID-19 Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Protocols at U.S.-Based

Lockheed Martin Facilities

The CDC recently <u>updated its COVID-19 quarantine and exposure guidance</u>. Public health officials still consider COVID-19 an ongoing threat; however, high levels of vaccine- and infection-induced immunity -- and the availability of medical and other interventions -- have substantially reduced the risk for significant illness, hospitalization and death from the virus.

To align with this guidance, the following protocols apply to persons coming to a U.S.-based Lockheed Martin facility, effective Aug. 16:

Onsite workers and visitors who have been <u>exposed</u> to someone infected with the coronavirus are no longer required to quarantine, regardless of vaccination status or previous infection. Instead, they must follow the close contact safety protocols summarized here:

- Wear a high-quality mask as soon as you find out you were exposed
- Monitor for symptoms if you develop symptoms, isolate immediately
- Get tested at least five full days after your last exposure
- If you test positive, isolate immediately
- If you test negative, continue to wear a mask through day 10

All individuals must still quarantine/isolate <u>per CDC guidance</u> if they test positive for COVID-19 or develop symptoms.

Masking and distancing will no longer be required, regardless of vaccination status or COVID-19 Community Level, except in specific situations, to maintain a safe workplace as follows:

- Masking after confirmed exposure to a person with COVID-19
- Masking as part of the post-quarantine protocol
- Where required by federal, state, local or site-specific rules and regulations

Onsite workers and visitors may choose to voluntarily wear a mask at any time. We expect those who enter our facilities to be considerate of the personal safety choices of Lockheed Martin employees and fellow visitors.
